

Sealocap™ Roof Seals MSDS Letter

Thank you for your inquire regarding an MSDS for Sealocap™ roof seals. However, we do not provide an MSDS due to the fact that this product is considered an "article" under the Hazard Communication Standard and is exempt from the MSDS requirement.

A hazardous chemical; as defined by the Hazard Communication Standard is any chemical, which can cause a physical or a health hazard. This determination is made by the chemical manufacturer, as described in 29 CFR 1 910.1200(d). Listed below is the section of the standard that defines an "article".

An article is defined in paragraph (c) of the Hazard Communication Standard as:

"a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle; (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees."

A product meeting this criterion is exempt from the MSDS requirement.
